Advantage of the ITRON specifications



- Compact and low-overhead real time kernel specifications
 - fit in a single chip MCU
- Easy to understand
- open specification
 - anyone can use the specification without any licensing fee
 - complete specification documents on the website (www.itron.gr.jp)
- Applicable to wide variety of processors
 - from low-cost 8 bit MCU to high performance 64 bit RISC
- Widely used for various embedded systems
 - used in over 30% of embedded systems in Japan
- Supported by many vendors
